THE ARTIST: Jacob Lawrence was born in 1917 and was a very young man when his painting career was at its height. He painted both historically significant moments of African American history as well as scenes from the daily life of ordinary people. His painting was representational and even narrative; some of his most famous work is images in a series such as the *Great Migration*, which tells the story of Black Americans moving from the south to the north after World War I.
